





# GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE RELATED TO THE COMPACT PROCUREMENT PLAN N°6 **AMENDMENTS N°1 & 2**

The Government of Benin acting through its representative - MCA-Benin II, has received grant funding amounting to Three Hundred and Seventy-Five Million United States Dollars (US \$375,000,000) from the Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC"), an agency of the United States Government, to enable MCA-Benin II to implement the MCC Compact and achieve its objectives. In the framework of this Program, it intends to apply part of the proceeds of the funds to payments for contracts for goods, works and services. The Government of Benin's contribution to the Program is Twenty-Eight Million One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand United States Dollars (US \$28,125,000).

These Amendments N°1 & 2 to the Procurement Plan N°6 that follows the Compact's entry into force on June 22, 2017 cover the period of October 2019 to September 2020. The activities that comprise the plan are as follows:

#### Estimated value : US \$ 44,657,788

Covered period: October 2019 - September 2020

#### **Procurement of Goods**

Procurement of goods for the Administration and Finance Direction (DAF), the Off-grid Electricity Access Project (OGEAP) and the Policy Reform and Institutional Strengthening Project (PRISP) of the MCA-Benin II Compact including:

# Administration and Finance Direction (DAF):

- Acquisition of computer hardware for MCA-Benin II;
- Acquisition of goods or non-consultant services for an amount less or equal to USD 5,000 per contract, to support the projects and the administration.

# Off-grid Electricity Access Project (OGEAP):

- Acquisition of PVSyst sofware and training of users for the benefit of ABERME;
- Acquisition of Retscreen Expert sofware (Professional mode) and training of users for the benefit of ABERME;
- Acquisition of a plotter for printing tracks on Autocad for the benefit of ABERME;
- Acquisition of MS Project sofware and training of users for the benefit of ABERME;
- Acquisition of Goods and related services for the implementation of energy efficiency measures in ten administrative buildings.

# Policy Reform and Institutional Strengthening Project (PRISP):

Selection of an equipment supplier to establish a testing laboratory for refrigerators and lamps.

## **Procurement of Works**

Procurement of works for the Electricity Distribution Project (EDP) of the MCA-Benin II Compact including:

Reinforcement and rehabilitation of the electricity distribution network in Cotonou and at the regional level: Sub-stations (relaunch of lot A).

• Selection of a Consultant for the implementation of Gender Audit recommendations.

Selection of a consultant for collecting reference data.
