## Main Text:

- 1. The government of Benin (the "Government") and the United States of America, through the Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC"), have entered into a Millennium Challenge Account Compact of approximately US \$ 391 million ("MCC Funding") to promote poverty reduction and economic growth in Benin (the "Compact"). The Government, acting through MCA-Benin II (the "MCA Entity"), intends to use part of the MCC Funding to eligible payments under the contract for which this Request for Applications ("RFA)") is launched. Any payments made by the MCA Entity in accordance with the proposed contract will be subject, in all respects, to the terms of the Compact and related documents, including restrictions on the use of the MCC Funding and disbursement conditions of the MCC Funding. No party other than the Government and the MCA Entity will obtain any right under the Compact or have any right in relation to the amounts of the MCC Funding.
- MCC's funding is appropriated by the U.S. Congress and obligated to the Compact upfront, with no incremental or partial funding. So, when a contract is signed with an MCA Entity, money is already available to the MCA Entity and, for most contracts, invoices are paid directly to Contractors/Consultants/Suppliers by the US Treasury.
- 3. The Benin power program consists of four (4) projects: (i) Policy Reform and Institutional Strengthening Project; (ii) Electricity Generation Project; (iii) Electricity Distribution Project; and (iv) Off-grid Electricity Access Project. The objective of the programme is to increase the productivity and production for businesses, generate more economic opportunities for households and improve the capacity to provide public and social services by improving the quantity and quality of power supply. The Compact will be executed during a period of five years after its entry into force, that intervened on June 22, 2017. To face the challenges of the Covid pandemic, the Compact has been extended to June 22, 2023.
- 4. MCA-Benin II now invites eligible individual consultants to submit a letter of application, a Curriculum Vitae (CV), comments on the Termes of reference and a financial offer for Selection of a Senior Individual Consultant to assist MCA-Benin II in the preparation of the Program completion report.
- 5. The mission will take place from the date of contract signature until the Compact End Date, i.e. June 22, 2023.
- 6. The qualifications required from the Consultant are indicated in the Terms of Reference contained in the RFA. They include among other the following:
  - (a) Academics qualifications
    - At least a Master 2 degree (BAC + 5) in Economics, Statistics, Planning, Evaluation or Management of Projects / Policies, or equivalent.
  - (b) Professionals' experiences
    - Have at least seven (7) years of experience in the management or monitoring and evaluation of Development Projects/Programs.
    - Have successfully completed at least three (03) missions for the preparation of a final report or the completion of a development project/program financed by international development organizations or other bilateral and multilateral Technical and Financial Partners (World Bank, UNDP, AFDB, EU, AFD, etc.).
    - Good writing and communication skills.
    - Have a good knowledge of Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, MS-Project, etc.).

- Have a good knowledge of French and English (reading, writing, and speaking).
- Ability to work in complete autonomy and in a team with various actors and in a multicultural and multidisciplinary environment.
- Have successfully prepared at least one (01) completion report of an MCA program.
- 7. This RFA is open to all eligible Individual Consultants, as defined in the MCC Program Procurement Guidelines (PPG), available on the MCC website (www.mcc.gov), who wish to participate. The Individual consultants cannot associate in groups or subcontract the services.
- 8. This RFA follows the Compact General Procurement Notice No. 18, published on dgMarket on October 13th, 2022, on the MCA Entity website www.mcabenin2.bj on October 14th, 2022, in the UN Development Business Online ("UNDB") on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and in the local newspapers "La Nation" on October 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and "Le Matinal" on October 20<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- 9. The Consultant shall be selected through the Individual Consultant selection procedures as specified in the MCC PPG (P.1. B.3.9.).
