



GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE RELATED TO THE COMPACT PROCUREMENT PLAN N°4

The Government of Benin acting through its representative - MCA-Benin II, has received grant funding amounting to Three Hundred and Seventy-Five Million United States Dollars (US \$375,000,000) from the Millennium Challenge Corporation ("MCC"), an agency of the United States Government, to enable MCA-Benin II to implement the MCC Compact and achieve the objectives. In the framework of this Program, it intends to apply parts of the proceeds of the funds to payments for contracts for goods, works and services. The Government of Benin's contribution to the Program is Twenty-Eight Million, One Hundred and Twenty-Five Thousand United States Dollars (US \$28,125,000).

This Procurement Plan N°4 that follows the Compact's entry into force on June 22, 2017 covers the period of April 2019 to March 2020. The activities that comprise the plan are as follows:

Covered period: April 2019 - March 2020

Procurement of Goods

Procurement of goods for the Administration and Finance Direction (DAF), the Monitoring & Evaluation (SE) Direction, the Policy Reform and Institutional Strengthening Project (PRISP), the Off-grid Electricity Access Project (OGEAP) and the Electricity Distribution Project (EDP) of the MCA-Benin II Compact including:

Administration and Finance Direction (DAF):

- Acquisition of office furniture for the Implementing Entities and MCA-Benin II;
- Acquisition of mobile phones for the Implementing Entities and MCA-Benin II.

Monitoring & Evaluation (SE) Direction:

Acquisition and installation of smart meters for collecting data from the SBEE subscribers.

Policy Reform and Institutional Strengthening Project (PRISP):

- Selection of equipment suppliers to establish a testing laboratory for refrigerators and lamps;
- Acquisition and installation of automatic weather stations at the four (04) sites of PV solar power plants;
- Technical Assistance by METEO BENIN (National Meteorological Agency) in the framework of the acquisition and installation of four automatic stations.

Off-grid Electricity Access Project (OGEAP):

- Acquisition of measurement equipment for the energy audits and the monitoring of electrification works;
- Acquisition of PVSyst sofware and training of users for the benefit of the implementing entities;
- Acquisition of MAPSource sofware and training of users for the benefit of the implementing entities;



Acquisition of AUTOCAD sofware and training of users for the benefit of the implementing entities.

Electricity Distribution Project (EDP)

Acquisition of personal protective equipment for the implementing entities.

Procurement of Works

Procurement of works for the Electricity Distribution Project (EDP) of the MCA-Benin II Compact including:

Cotonou and regional Grid Strengthening: Construction works and extension of 161 kV and 63 kV substations.

Procurement of Consultant Services

Contracts with firms for Consultant Services for the Environmental and Social Performance (ESP) Department, the Monitoring & Evaluation (SE) Direction, the Electricity Distribution Project (EDP), the "Gender integration and Social Inclusion" (GSI) Department and the Communication and Public Relations Direction (DCRP) of the MCA-Benin II Compact including:

Selection of a Consultant for the waste management identified by the Hazardous Materials study.
